How to Make Email Links Work on Your Device

A guide to ensure clicking "Email Order" or other mailto: links works properly across devices.

macOS (Mac)

- 1. Open the Mail app
- 2. Go to Mail > Settings (or Preferences)
- 3. In the General tab, find "Default email reader"
- 4. Choose: Apple Mail, Outlook, Chrome (for Gmail), or another installed app

If your desired app doesn't appear, open it once, then return to this menu.

Windows 10

- 1. Go to Start > Settings
- 2. Click Apps > Default Apps
- 3. Scroll down to Email
- 4. Choose your email app (Mail, Outlook, Chrome, etc.)

Windows 11

- 1. Open Settings
- 2. Go to Apps > Default Apps
- 3. Search for the email app you want to use
- 4. Click it and scroll to find MAILTO
- 5. Click MAILTO and set it to your preferred app

iPhone / iPad (iOS)

- 1. Download your preferred email app (e.g., Gmail, Outlook)
- 2. Open the Settings app
- 3. Scroll to and tap on the email app
- 4. Tap Default Mail App
- 5. Select Gmail or Outlook

Android

- 1. Go to Settings > Apps > Default Apps
- 2. Tap Email app
- 3. Choose Gmail, Outlook, or another app

Alternate: Open Gmail > Tap Profile > Settings and accept prompt to make Gmail default

Chrome for Gmail (Web)

- 1. Go to https://mail.google.com
- 2. Look for the icon in the address bar
- 3. Click it and select "Allow" Gmail to open email links

If not visible:

- Go to chrome://settings/handlers
- Enable 'Sites can ask to handle protocols'
- Reload Gmail

Troubleshooting Tips

Problem: Nothing happens \rightarrow Fix: Set your default email app

Problem: Opens wrong app → Fix: Reset default settings

Problem: Gmail not opening → Fix: Enable Gmail handler in Chrome

Problem: Device is managed by $IT \rightarrow Fix$: Contact your admin

Problem: Link doesn't work on mobile → Fix: Set default mail app in mobile settings
